White Wine

1. **Chardonnay, Five Foot Track, South Eastern Australia, Australia** 2019 £19.00
An easy-going Chardonnay with ripe tropical fruit flavours of pineapple and mango, with hints of vanilla and a buttery finish. Try with BBQ chicken, grilled shellfish and creamy pasta dishes.

2. **Pinot Grigio, Crescendo, Veneto, Italy** 2019 £19.00
This Pinot Grigio is a fresh easy-drinking Italian white with subtle citrus fruit flavours.

3. **Viña Carrasco, Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile** 2019 £19.00
This classic is from one of Chile's most prestigious award-winning wine makers. You will find a hint of grapefruit, fresh mown grass and clear citrus. Finished with hints of acidity.

6. **Viognier, Vieilles Vignes, Mont Rocher, France** 2019 £22.00
A white from the South of France that is very aromatic with a peachy, honeysuckle and apricot aroma. Providing a refreshing lingering dry tangy palate. Pasta dishes, seafood dishes, and salads go well with the crisp yet fruity notes of the Viognier grape.
11. **Muscadet Côtes du Grandlieu Sur Lie, Domaine des Herbauges, France** 2015 £23.00
Highly rated, elegant and beautifully balanced, this Muscadet is perfect for seafood. With a deep, golden colour, the palate is punctuated by flattering lemon notes with a light crisp finish.
8. **Sauvignon Blanc, Finger Post, Marlborough, New Zealand** 2019 £24.00
An elegant Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of gooseberries and tropical fruit leading to a crisp and refreshing finish.
7. **Picpoul Plo D'Isabelle, France** 2019 £26.00
A snappy nose of lemon and lime fruit, with vibrant green apple. A racy wine with a lip tingling finish.
9. **Macon-Villages Blanc, "Les Pierres Blanches", Cave de Lugny, France** 2018 £27.00
It is fruity, juicy and refreshing - think citrus, green melon and a touch of honey, with a lip-smacking finish. An all-rounder which will please everyone.
12. **Chablis, Domaine Savary, Burgundy, France** 2018 £37.00
This atypical Chablis is produced with fruit characters of crunchy green apple and tart citrus fruit, combining with the background hints of sea air, chalk dust and minerality.
13. **Chablis, Domaine Grossot, France - Magnum** 2012 £75.00
14. **Sancerre Chene de Roy, Domaine Girault, Loire, France** 2018 £47.00
Unlike other Sauvignon Blanc's, the ones that are grown here are crisp, well-balanced and highly aromatic. Due to the nature of where it is grown, they produce a distinct mineral touch to them.
16. **Pierre Bouree, Bourgogne Blanc, France** 2015 £52.00
This beautifully balanced and classic white Burgundy has a savoury, salty, biscuity nose with a restrained, mineral palate.
15. **Puligny Montrachet, Les Houillères, France** 2018 £60.00
Fresh and lifted in style, with a touch of spice and roasted hazelnut on the palate enhancing the ripe, opulent orchard fruit. Soft, rounded and very harmonious.

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| 20. | Marques de Calado Tempranillo, Vino de la Tierra Castilla, Spain | 2018 | £18.00 |
| | <i>Classic Tempranillo with notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant, lifted by a hint of dried flowers and spice. Superbly balanced, the forest flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins.</i> | | |

| 21. | Merlot, Hillville Road, Australia | 2018 | £18.00 |
| | <i>This Merlot is ripe, fruity, medium bodied red with smooth black fruit aromas, with a taste plum, raspberry and a touch of spice. Great by itself, or would match well with roast meats and pastas.</i> | | |

| 22. | Shiraz, Big Bombora, Australia | 2017 | £18.00 |
| | <i>A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit & savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent & mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry & brambles.</i> | | |

| 26. | Malbec, Aires Andinos, Mendoza, Argentina | 2019 | £20.00 |
| | <i>An intense red-purple colour, with an equally intense nose of plum and bramble. Round and fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins. Enjoy this with beef or lamb.</i> | | |
| 27. | Rioja, Conde de Castile, Spain | 2015 | £25.00 |
| | <i>A lovely dark Rioja, with dark fruits and hints of spice. Goes perfectly with steak</i> | | |
| 29. | Three Vintners, Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia | 2018 | £25.00 |
| | <i>A celebration of three generations of family winemakers, it is a luscious, bold and chock-full of black fruits, mocha and sweet spice.</i> | | |
| 33. | Château Moulin de Mallet, Bordeaux, France | 2018 | £27.00 |
| | <i>Great colour for such a modest wine. Very dense and sweet on the palate, with lots of fruit and a juicy feel ahead of a lightly grippy finish. Goes well with pasta dishes.</i> | | |
| 34. | Château Moulin de Mallet, Bordeaux, France – Magnum | 2018 | £52.00 |
| 24. | Château Haut Grelot, Premières Côte de Blaye, Bordeaux, France | 2016 | £29.00 |
| | <i>Bargain Bordeaux that delivers. Aged for a limited time in oak, it has delicious plummy fruit supported by silky tannins.</i> | | |
| 32. | Lussac Saint Emilion, France | 2016 | £31.00 |
| | <i>Well-structured and intense, with red fruit notes buoyed by facets of leather, plum, spice, and tertiary game note. An elegant claret.</i> | | |
| 28. | Pinot Noir, Sherwood Estate, Waipara Valley, New Zealand | 2019 | £34.00 |
| | <i>This bottle is the signature wine of Sherwood estate. Aromas of violets and wood-smoke follow through to a complex palate of raspberry fruit and spice with a lingering smoky finish.</i> | | |

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30.	Fleurie, "Les Roches du Vivier", Domaine Berrod, Burgundy, France <i>Fragrant berry nose enhanced by notes of earth and dried meat. Plush and velvety palate, with an appealing weight of savoury dark fruit tempered by a fresh acid lift.</i>	2018	£39.00
31.	Château les Platanes, Côtes de Bordeaux, France <i>A superb ruby red colour, a very fruity nose and mouth with notes of wood and spices. This soft wine will be perfect with red or white meats and cheeses.</i>	2016	£39.00
37.	Chorey le Beaune, Marchard de Gramont, Bourgogne, France <i>Aged in 11th-century cellar for up to 14 months in both French and American oak. Expect notes of red and black fruits, elegant tannins and a delicious aftertaste from this red Burgundy.</i>	2017	£39.00
36.	Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Closerie de Vaudieu, Château de Vaudieu, France <i>An excellent Châteauneuf-du-Pape with fragrant berry fruits on the nose, a touch of liquorice and hints of black pepper. On the palate, it is full-bodied, and the ripe tannins gently support the cherry, cassis and herb character on the finish.</i>	2017	£62.00
35.	Crozes-Hermitage, Les Pierrelles, Syrah, France <i>Notes of vanilla up front. Full-bodied, fruity but less acidic than other Syrah's. Blackberry notes with a decent number of tannins.</i>	2017	£62.00

40.	Pinot Grigio Rosé, Torre Alta, Veneto, Italy <i>A very popular Rosé, with aromas of peach and apricot. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes. Great with all salads.</i> Available by the Glass: 175ml or 250ml	2019	£20.00
44.	Jas de Vignes Rosé, IGP Méditerranée, Italy <i>This dry wine emits delicious hints of watermelon, peach and ripe strawberry. With its stylish bottle and delicate pink hue, it is a high-quality Provence-style rosé.</i>	2019	£24.00
41.	Domaine St Mitre, Coteaux Varois, Provence Rosé, France <i>An exquisite Rosé with tropical fruits and grapefruit on the nose. On the palate it has a lemon zest finish and a mouth-watering acidity.</i>	2019	£27.00
