

## 2018 MORGAN CUP RACE

### AMENDMENT ONE - TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

*Delete 9 and replace with:*

#### 9 IDENTITY GATE

- 9.1 An identity gate will be established between Cowes Corinthian Buoy (yellow spherical buoy with "X" on top, approximate position 50° 46'.15N 001° 17'.20W) and a gate boat lying to the south of Cowes Corinthian Buoy, displaying a blue flag with a white border and a white seahorse over a yellow flag.
- 9.2 The gate will be available from 60 minutes before the first start until about 10 minutes after the last start, or later at the discretion of the committee. Each boat shall pass once through the gate in a **westerly** direction with her engine running, displaying her sail numbers and letters secured to the lifelines on the port side. In addition, **lifejackets for all crew members and a floating waterproof torch for use in the event of a man overboard at night (in accordance with World Sailing Special Regulations 5.01 and 4.07 e) shall be displayed** and the boat shall receive visual acknowledgement before starting.
- 9.3 **Warning:** Boats which do not pass through the gate correctly are liable to disqualification.
- 9.4 **After the start** when sail numbers are not displayed elsewhere (sails down) they shall be displayed secured to the lifelines on the port quarter.
