## **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS- SCORING**

**Purpose** - A number of scoring queries have been asked of both the 2018 IRC European Championships and the 2018 Commodores' Cup. This notice aims to clarify those queries in line with the Notice of Race.

### 2018 IRC European Championship

#### **1.13.2 Series Scores**

At least 4 races, including either the Long Offshore Race or the Race Around the Isle of Wight, must be completed to constitute a series.

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

The overall winner of the IRC European Championship Trophy will be the boat with the best score when the following is applied; A yacht's series score divided by (number of scored races minus (-) 1) divided by (Number of entries in class plus (+) 2). As per NOR 1.14.1.

#### **1.13.3 Series Ties**

A tie in overall points will be broken by the points gained in the Offshore Race, or if that fails, the Round the Isle of Wight Race. If a tie still remains the International Jury shall determine the outcome (changes RRS A8).

### 2018 Commodores' Cup

Teams shall consist of any 3 yachts from any fleet or class in the 2018 IRC Europeans Championship that comply with the eligibility requirements outlined in APPENDIX A of the Notice of Race.

#### **1.13.2 Series Scores**

Commodores Cup entrants will be scored in a separate series.

The Commodores Cup shall be determined by taking each competitor's Commodores Cup series score and applying a class/ fleet multiplier to her score based on total number of Commodores' Cup entrants in her class/ fleet. The total lowest team score (as per RRS 2017-2020 A4) shall be the Commodores Cup winner.
