



IRC Double Handed National Championship 2019 Amendment number One to the Sailing Instructions

DELETE: 14 PENALTIES, PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

INSERT: 14 PENALTIES, PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

14.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the penalty for a boat breaking a rule in Part 2 shall be a One-Turn Penalty (1 tack and 1 gybe).

14.2 Boats intending to protest or request redress for an incident in the racing area should radio their intention to the RC as soon as practical after finishing or retiring from the race concerned, naming any other boats involved, and await an acknowledgement. This adds to RRS 61.1(a).

14.3 Exoneration Penalty: A boat that may have broken a rule of Part 2 or RRS 31 may, after finishing the race concerned and before the start of a related protest hearing, notify the RC that she accepts a 20% scoring penalty.

14.4 Protest forms are available at the race office. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.

14.5 The protest time limit is 90 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.

14.6 Notices will be posted within 20 minutes of the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. The location and time of hearings will be posted.

14.7 Notices of protests by the RC or protest committee will be posted to inform boats under RRS 61.1(b).

14.8 On the last scheduled day of racing a request for redress from a protest committee decision shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. This changes RRS 62.2.
